



FINAL MEETING REPORT

On the 6-7 November 2019 was organized in Bucharest the third transnational meeting in the frame of the Sport together, active forever Project (Erasmus+ Sport - Small Collaborative Partnerships: 590526–EPP–1–2017–1–RO–SPO–SSCP; Grant Agreement: 2017–3137/001–001). This was organized by the National University of Physical Education and Sport Bucharest in its quality of the project coordinator and the Down Plus Bucharest Asociation as a partner in the project.

The activities lasted 2 days and all project partners had people involved: 4 from Latvia, 5 from Spain and 8 from Romania from the two partners involved in the project.

During the meeting, more activities were organized:

6.11.2019 – the Agenda was made up of 2 sessions. During the morning, the meeting was organized in the UNEFS Museum and contained:

- wellcome from the Management Staff of the University
- the presentation of the project
- the presentation of the dissemination activities realized by every partners.

At this part of the meeting, the hosts had invited 16 persons (the representative of different NGOs, teachers, students, a.o.). There were discussions and questions at which the coordinator and the members of the project team answered.

During the afternoon, the participants were involved in a local bocce competition. In this competiton, the foreign partners played bocce together with the 20 Romanian sportsmen who made up the target group of the project. The competiton were organized in the game hall of the University and lasted 2 hours.

7.11.2019 – the Agenda was made up of 2 sessions, too. During the morning, the project partners (17 persons) went on the project meeting. The discussions focused on:

- the presentation of the dissemination activities planned in November and December and the discussions about the activities that all partners would organize during the sustainability period of time
- the discussions about the final report and the tasks of all the partners for its reporting.

Finally, the activities of the transnational meeting were evaluated by the participants based on scores. The average of the scores granted for all the interventions was above 9.

On the second afternoon, all the persons involved in the project attended the activity organized by the Down Plus Bucharest Association at their location.
